4. Registered Individuals

The registry consists of participants and exhibitors of BNAM 2024.

5. Basis and Purpose of Data Processing

The processing of personal data is based on the consent of the participants. Personal data is used for event communication and invoicing of participation fees.

6. Processed Personal Data

The registry contains the participant's name, organization, billing information, any reported food allergies, and email address.

7. Regular Data Sources

The registry members serve as the source of information.

8. Data Sharing and Transfer

The registry's data is not disclosed to external parties without the consent of the registered individuals. The registry's data is not transferred outside the EU/EEA countries.

9. Data Security

Access to the registry is limited to individuals whose duties require access to the registry.

10. Data Processing Duration

Personal data is retained until event-related communication and invoicing have been completed.

11. Data Processors

In addition to the data controller, the registry's data is processed by the society's service provider, who maintains the registry in an electronic database.

12. Automated Decision-Making and Profiling

The registry does not include automated decision-making or profiling.

13. Rights of the Registered Individuals

Every registered individual has the right to:

- Access their personal data stored in the registry. If there are inaccuracies or omissions in the data, the registered individual may request corrections or additions.
- Object to the processing of their personal data if they believe that their data has been processed unlawfully or without proper authorization.
- Request the deletion of data stored in the registry. The registered individual also has the right to restrict data processing.
- Data portability, which allows the transfer of their data from one system to another.
- File a complaint with the Data Protection Ombudsman if they believe that the processing of their personal data has violated current data protection legislation.

The data controller may only refuse to implement an objection or deletion request on legal grounds. If the data controller does not comply with the registered individual's requests, the registered individual has the right to file a complaint with the Data Protection Ombudsman. The registered individual also has the right to request that the processing of disputed data be restricted until the matter is resolved.

15. Changes to the Privacy Policy
